COGS Falmouth - Roscoff Cross-Channel Race– 29th April 2022

The Plymouth Fowey Falmouth Triangle Race 30th April and 1st May 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following races are planned:

The COGS Annual Coastal Race from Falmouth to Roscoff is planned to take place on: 29th April 2022. The race is planned to start on a line from Pendennis Headland to Black Rock. Start is expected around 1830 on 29th April, with 5 to 10 yachts expected to take part. Race officer will be using VHF channel 69.

The Plymouth Fowey Falmouth Triangle Race is taking place as follows:

Saturday 30th April 2022 – The race will depart from Plymouth in the morning with vessels expected to arrive over the afternoon of the same day. The finish line is between Pendennis point and Black Rock Beacon.

Sunday 1st May – The race will depart from Falmouth to Fowey in three classes from around 10:25 to 10:45. The start line will be between Pendennis point and Black Rock Beacon.

There will be approximately 40 vessels taking part.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13 <https://www.falmouthharbour.co.uk/wp/wp-content/uploads/30-130-01-FHC-Byelaws.pdf> which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.
