

Falmouth Harbour Leisure Strop Hire 2023

Background

We are committed to ensuring a safe, environmentally sound and enjoyable harbour for everyone. In 2023 we will provide Falmouth Harbour strops for all our moorings. This is to help manage vessel swinging circles, which will reduce the likelihood of collisions and ensure vessels stay secure in all weather conditions. It will also allow us to operate a smooth, efficient and more standardised maintenance schedule across our 600 seasonal moorings.

We have also had some private strop failures and near misses - we want to eliminate these.

Applying for your 2023 mooring

In order to secure your Falmouth Harbour mooring for 2023 season, please complete this questionnaire before 31 October 2022.

Without full details of your vessel and strop requirements, we are unable to take your 2023 booking.

Key dates

31 October 2022: Summer season ends

31 October 2022: Deadline for 2023 mooring applications

October – November 2022: All strops removed from all moorings for maintenance

March 2023: Falmouth Harbour strops fitted to moorings

1 April 2023: Summer season begins

In 2023 we will provide Falmouth Harbour strops for all our moorings which can be hired out annually for your vessel.

When applying for your 2023 mooring, you'll need to complete our questionnaire and choose one of the following strop options:

Your strop measurements

In order to ensure vessels are safe, that there is correct loading on the mooring buoy and to manage swinging circles, it's important that we get the following measurements from you so that we may organise a strop for your mooring. You will only need to provide these details for the first year, as we will then have all the information for ongoing seasons
